*Notice respecting Proposed Alteration of Boundaries, Borough of Balclutha*

IT is hereby notified that a petition has been presented to His Excellency the Governor-General, under the Municipal Corporations Act, 1933, praying that the area described in the Schedule hereto may be excluded from the County of Clutha and included in the Borough of Balclutha.
