Exemption Order under the Motor-drivers Regulations 1940

PURSUANT to the Motor drivers Regulations 1940,* the Minister **P** of Transport doth hereby order and declare that the provisions of clause (1) of Regulation 7 of the said regulations, so far as they relate to the driving of heavy trade motors, shall not apply to the person hereinafter mentioned, but in lieu thereof the following provision shall apply :-
