EXPLANATORY NOTE

EXPLANATORY NOTE The foregoing notice does not operate as a prohibition of the sale of any flock but is only a preliminary declaration specifying the kind of flock with respect to which the Tribunal has authority to prohibit the sale under the powers conferred on it by subclause (2) of clause 9 of the regulations cited in the notice. It is not the intention of the Tribunal to exercise its powers of prohibition (except in the event of special circumstances) for at least four weeks after the publication of the above notice in the Gazette. With respect to the flock of the kind specified in the Schedule to the notice the Tribunal advises that application for its approval of proposed prices should be made to the Tribunal as soon as possible, and draws attention of all persons concerned to the fact that, at any time after the expiration of four weeks from the publication of and draws autention of an persons concerned to the fact that, at any time after the expiration of four weeks from the publication of the notice, it may proceed, in accordance with the powers conferred on it by the regulations, to prohibit the sale of any such flock otherwise than at prices fixed or approved by the Tribunal.
