WHEREAS in pursuance of section one hundred and thirtywas presented to the Governor-General praying that certain areas be excluded from the County of Southland and included in the City of Invercargill:

And whereas a Commission appointed under the said section held inquiries and recommended that portions of the said areas be excluded from the County of Southland and included in the City of Invercargill:

And whereas it is deemed expedient to make the alterations of boundaries recommended by the said Commission :

Now, therefore, in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in him by the Municipal Corporations Act, 1933, and of all other powers and authorities enabling him in that behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby declare that as on and from the first day of April, one thousand nine hundred and forty-seven, the areas described in the Schedule hereto shall be excluded from the County of Southland and included in the City of Invercarcill. Invercargill.
