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MANIOTOTO COUNTY COUNCIL

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

**I**N pursuance and in exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, and of all other powers (if any) it thereunto enabling, the Maniototo County Council hereby resolves as follows:—

“That, for the purpose of providing for the payment of principal, interest, sinking fund, and other charges on the Housing Loan, 1945, of £6,750, authorized to be raised by the Council under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose of the provision of workers' dwellings in terms of section 192 of the Counties Act, 1920, the said Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of one-eighth of a penny (¼d.) in the pound on the rateable value (on the basis of the capital value) of all rateable property in the County of Maniototo; and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable annually on the 31st day of March in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty-seven years or until the loan is fully paid off.”
