

the northern boundary of the other part of Allotment 337A and part Allotment 235, all of Waipu Parish, part of the northern boundary of Section 1, Block XI, Waipu Survey District, a right line across a public road, the northern boundary of the other part of the said Section 1, the north-western boundary of part Section 5, Block X, Waipu Survey District, a right line being the production of the southern end of the last-mentioned boundary, across a public road to its south-eastern side, the north-western boundary of Sections part 5, 4, 3A, and 3, all of the said Block X, to the eastern side of a public road, a right line across the aforesaid public road to the northern corner of Section 2 of the aforesaid Block X, part of the northern boundary of that section, a right line across another public road, the northern boundary of the other parts of the said Section 2, to and down middle of the Piroa Stream, the south-western boundary of Waipu Parish, part of the south-western boundary of Ruarangi Parish, the south-eastern boundary of Waikiekie Parish, the south-eastern and south-western boundaries of Tauraroa Parish, crossing intervening roads, to a point in line with the north-western boundary of Allotment 166, Omaru Parish, a right line in the direction of the northern end of the last-mentioned boundary to the middle of the Mangonui River, down the middle of that river to its confluence with the Tauraroa River, up the middle of that river to a point in line with the production southward of the eastern boundary of Lot 44 on the plan numbered 8548, deposited in the office of the District Land Registrar at Auckland, being part of Walton's Grant; thence northerly generally along a right line to Trig. Station M 2, in Block X, Purua Survey District; thence north-westerly along a right line to Trig. Station L 1, Tautewhananga, in Block IX, Purua Survey District; thence westerly along a right line to the south-western corner of Section 8, Block XII, Mangakahia Survey District, and a right line to Trig. Station 40A, Tiratutumumu, in Block XI, Mangakahia Survey District; thence north-westerly along a right line to the eastern end of the northern boundary of the middle portion of Nukutawhiti Block, being a point on the boundary of the Whangarei County; thence north-easterly and northerly generally along that county boundary, being the south-western and northern boundaries generally of the Kaikou No. 3 Block, the northern boundary of the Mangakowhara Block, the western and northern boundaries of Section N.W. 13, Block XIII, Hukerenui Survey District, across a public road, the western boundaries of Sections 24 and 23, the northern boundary of 23, the eastern boundaries of 23 and 24, both of Block IX, Hukerenui Survey District, the northern boundaries of Sections 5, 4, and 3, Block XIII aforesaid, the western boundary of Section 32, Block X, Hukerenui Survey District, the south-western, western, and northern boundaries of Section 32, Block IX aforesaid, a right line bearing due north across a public road, the northern boundary of Section 52, Block X aforesaid, across a public road, the western and northern boundaries of Section 51, the western boundaries of Sections 50 and 48, a right line across a public road, the western and northern boundaries of Section 61, a right line across a public road, the northern boundaries of Sections 49 and 38, all of Block X, Hukerenui Survey District, part of the western boundary of Section 19, Block X aforesaid, and its production northward across the Whangarei-Kawakawa Main Highway, the northern side of that highway, across a public road intersecting Section 17, Block X aforesaid, the eastern side of that road, down the middle of the Ngaruawahine Stream, up the middle of the Waitoa River, the north-western boundary of Section 66, Block VI, Hukerenui Survey District, across a public road, the western and northern boundaries of Section 65, part of the north-eastern and northern boundaries of Section 50, all of Block VI aforesaid, the western boundary of Puhipuhi No. 4A 1 Block, the western boundaries of Sections 4 and 3, both of Block VII, Hukerenui Survey District, the northern boundary of Section 3 aforesaid, the western boundaries of Sections 6 and 5, Block VII aforesaid, and 13 and 12 of Block III of that survey district, across a public road, the western, northern, and eastern boundaries of Section 11, Block III aforesaid, across a public road, part of the northern boundary of Section 11, Block IV, Hukerenui Survey District, the western boundary of Section 3, Block IV aforesaid, the southern and western boundaries of Paremata-Mokau Block, the western and north-western boundaries of Punaruku No. 2 Block, the western boundary of Waikokopu Block, the western boundaries of Sections 5 and 6, Block XII, Russell Survey District, the western boundary of the Tutamatai Block, the north-eastern boundary of that block, the north-western boundary of Whangaroa-Ngaibonga No. 4C Block, the north-western and northern boundaries of Whangaroa-Ngaibonga No. 4F Block, to a point on the sea-coast, being the point of commencement.

THE MANGAKAHIA TRIBAL DISTRICT

All that portion of the Whangarei County, bounded by a line commencing at the eastern end of the northern boundary of the middle portion of the Nukutawhiti Block; thence south-easterly along a right line to Trig. Station 40A, Tiratutumumu, in Block XI, Mangakahia Survey District; thence easterly along a right line to the south-western corner of Section 8, Block XII, Mangakahia Survey District, and a right line to Trig. Station L 1, Tautewhananga, in Block IX, Purua Survey District; thence south-easterly along a right line to Trig. Station M 2, in Block X, Purua Survey District; thence southerly along a right line to a point in the middle of the Tauraroa River in line with the production southward of the eastern boundary of Lot 44 on the plan numbered 8548, deposited in the office of the District Land Registrar at Auckland, being part of Walton's Grant, the said point being a point on the boundary of the Whangarei County; thence north-westerly, westerly, northerly, and easterly generally along that county boundary, being a right line to the southern end of the eastern boundary of Lot 44 aforesaid, the eastern boundary of the said Lot 44, part of the northern boundary of Lot 43 on the plan numbered 8548 aforesaid, the eastern boundary of Block VII, Tangihua Survey District, the eastern boundary of Block I of that survey district, the south-western boundary of Sections E. 9, S.W. 9,

and 14, the western boundaries of Sections 14, 15, and 16, all of the aforesaid Block III, the south-western boundaries of Sections 7, E. 8, W. 8, S.E. 9, N.W. 9, 10, 11, Part 12, 13, and 14, the south-western and north-western boundaries of Section 15, all of the aforesaid Block I, the southern and south-western boundaries of Lot 2 on the plan numbered 13137, deposited in the office of the District Land Registrar at Auckland, being part of Pukepukerau Block, across a public road, the western boundary of Ti Iweri Block, the south-western and north-western boundaries of Panehuri Block, the north-western boundary of Ngawhakarikiriki Block, the production of that block to the middle of the Waitotama River, the middle of that river, a right line to the eastern boundary of Section 4, Block IV, Maungaru Survey District, the eastern boundary of Section 4 aforesaid, a right line to the right bank of the said river, across a public road, the eastern and northern boundaries of the said Section 4, the northern boundary of Section 1, Block IV, and its production to the middle of the Wairua River, the middle of that river to its confluence with the Mangakahia River, the middle of the last-mentioned river to a point in line with the south-eastern end of a road forming the eastern boundary of Section 8, Block XV, Mangakahia Survey District, the said south-eastern end of that road, the north-eastern boundary of Maungaru Block, the south-eastern, eastern, and north-eastern boundaries of the provisional State Forest (*Gazette*, 1922, page 1921), the northern boundary of Section 19, Block XIV, Mangakahia Survey District, the north-eastern boundary of Lot 13 on the plan numbered 12412, deposited in the office of the District Land Registrar at Auckland, being part of Te Karaka Block, the north-eastern and north-western boundaries of Lot 12 of a subdivision of Te Karaka Block aforesaid, across a public road, the north-eastern and north-western boundaries of Lot 10, the north-eastern boundary of Lot 25, the south-eastern, north-eastern, and north-western boundaries of Lot 24, across a public road, the north-western boundary of Lot 5, the aforesaid lots all being part of Te Karaka Block, the southern boundary of Lot 1 of Section 10, Block XII, Tutamoe Survey District, the production of the last-mentioned boundary across Section 9 of the said Block XII, the western boundary of the said Section 9, across a public road, the northern boundaries of Sections 9 and 10, Block XI, Tutamoe Survey District, the north-western boundary of Section 10 aforesaid, the north-eastern boundary of State forest (*Gazette*, 1940, page 1126), the eastern boundary of Section 5, Block X, Tutamoe Survey District, a right line across the Opoutiki River and a public road, the eastern boundaries of Section 4, Block X aforesaid, and of Sections 15 and 12, Block VI, Tutamoe Survey District, across a public road, the generally eastern side of that road forming the western boundaries of Sections 10 and 15, Block VII, and Lot 2 of Section 13, Block III of the said survey district, again across that road, the generally eastern and northern boundaries of Section 12A, the eastern boundary of Section 4A, both of Block II, Tutamoe Survey District, the southern side of the road forming the northern boundary of Section 13A, Block III aforesaid, a right line across a road to the south-eastern corner of Section 1, Block II aforesaid, a right line to the southern corner of Section 6, Block XV, Puna-kitere Survey District, across another public road, and to the middle of the Mangakahia River in line with the western boundary of Section 3, Block XV aforesaid, the northern and north-eastern boundaries of Section 3 aforesaid, the middle of a small stream forming part of the last-mentioned north-eastern boundary, the middle of the Mangakahia River, a right line to and along the north-eastern boundary of Aukumeroa No. 2 Block and its production to the middle of the Mangakahia River, the middle of that river and the Awarua River, the northern boundary of the middle portion of the Nukutawhiti Block to its eastern end, being the point of commencement.

THE HOBSON TRIBAL DISTRICT

All that area in the North Auckland Land District, being Hobson County, as described in the *New Zealand Gazette* of 28th January, 1932, at page 149, and the western half of the Wairoa River and the Kaipara Harbour joining that county.

THE OTAMATEA TRIBAL DISTRICT

All that area in the North Auckland Land District, being the counties of Otamatea and Rodney and portion of the Wairoa River and Kaipara Harbour, bounded by a line commencing at a point in the middle of the Wairoa River in line with the north-western boundary of the Parish of Tokatoka; thence north-easterly along a right line to the westernmost corner of that parish, being a point on the boundary of the Otamatea County, as described in the *New Zealand Gazette* of 20th June, 1929, at page 1684; thence north-easterly, south-easterly, easterly, and southerly generally along the boundaries of the Otamatea County, as described in the *New Zealand Gazette* aforesaid, to the mouth of the Mangawai Harbour; then south-easterly across the mouth of that harbour to the sea-coast, being a point on the boundary of Rodney County, as described in the *New Zealand Gazette* of 28th March, 1929, at page 790; thence south-easterly, southerly, and westerly generally along the boundaries of the Rodney County, as described in the *New Zealand Gazette* aforesaid, to the middle of the Makarau River; thence south-westerly and north-westerly down the middle of that river and Kaipara Harbour, and up the middle of the Wairoa River to a point in line with the north-western boundary of the Parish of Tokatoka, being the point of commencement.
