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Additional Land at Auckland taken for the Purposes of the Kaipara-Waikato Railway

[L.S.] B. C. FREYBERG, Governor-General A PROCLAMATION

In pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby taken for the purposes of the Kaipara-Waikato Railway.

APPROXIMATE areas of the pieces of land :-

Being
Part Lot 3, D.P. 32693; coloured blue.
Section 40, Block VIII, Rangitoto Survey District; 0 1.6 coloured sepia.

Both being portions of the Waitemata Harbour reclaimed from the sea.

Situated in Block VIII, Rangitoto Survey District, City of Auckland. (S.O. 34423.)

Declaring Portions of Railway Land at Matai to be Crown Land

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby declare the land described in the Schedule hereto to be Crown land subject to the Land Act, 1924.

Allocating Railway Land to the Purposes of Street in the Borough of $Te\ Kuiti$

PURSUANT to section two hundred and twenty-six of the Public Works Act, 1928, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the land which is described in the Schedule hereto (and which was taken for the North Island Main Trunk Railway and is not now required for such purpose) shall, upon the publication hereof in the New Zealand Grantte heavens extract and that such street shall be maintained by Gazette, become street, and that such street shall be maintained by the Te Kuiti Borough Council in like manner as other streets are controlled and maintained by the said Council.

APPROXIMATE area of the piece of land dealt with: 6 perches. Being part Railway land in Proclamation No. 5129.

Situated in Block XV, Orahiri Survey District (Borough of Te Kuiti) (Auckland R.D.). (S.O. 31494.)
