ONE TREE HILL BOROUGH COUNCIL

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the One Tree Hill Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:—

“That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of £83,000, authorized to be raised by the One Tree Hill Borough Council under the above-mentioned Act for streets construction, the said One Tree Hill Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of sixpence halfpenny (6½d.) in the pound (on the basis of the annual value) upon the rateable value of all rateable property of the Borough of One Tree Hill; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of June in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty (20) years or until the loan is fully paid off.”
