TAIHAPE BOROUGH COUNCIL**RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE**

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Taihape Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:—

"That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of £24,000, authorized to be raised by the Taihape Borough Council under the above-mentioned Act for street improvements, the said Taihape Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of two and seven-eighths pence (2 $\frac{7}{8}$ d.) in the pound upon the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property of the Borough of Taihape; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of August in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty years or until the loan is fully paid off."

The above resolution was passed at a meeting of the Taihape Borough Council held on the 22nd day of April, 1947.
