RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

Electricity Reticulation Loan, 1946

IN pursuance and in exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, and its amendments, and of all other Acts, powers, and authorities enabling it in that behalf, the Whangarei Borough Council hereby resolves as follows—

TAURANGA COUNTY COUNCIL

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Municipal Corporations Act, 1933, and the Local Legislation Act, 1946 (section 16), the Napier Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:—
