WHEREAS by Order in Council made on the fourteenth day W of November, one thousand nine hundred and forty-five (hereinafter called the said Order in Council), and subject to the determinations as to borrowing and repayment therein set out, (hereinafter called the said local authority) of the sum of twenty thousand pounds ($\pounds 20,000$), to be known as "Harbour Works Loan, 1939, $\pounds 400,000$ (Fourth Issue, $\pounds 20,000$, 1945)" (hereinafter called the said loan):

And whereas the said loan has not yet been raised, and it is expedient to vary the determinations in respect thereof :

(1) In lieu of a term of thirty (30) years, as specified in clause one of the said Order in Council, the term for which the said loan or any part thereof may be raised shall not exceed twenty (20) years.

(2) In lieu of a rate of interest not exceeding three pounds ten shillings (£3 10s.) per centum per annum, as specified in clause two of the said Order in Council, the rate of interest that may be paid in respect of the said loan or any part thereof shall be such as shall not produce to the lender or lenders a rate or rates exceeding three pounds five shillings (£3 5s.) per centum per annum.

(3) In lieu of payments being made to the sinking fund esta-blished in accordance with clause three of the said Order in Council, at the rate of two pounds and fourpence ($\pounds 2$ 0s. 4d.) per centum, the payments shall be made at the rate of three pounds fourteen shillings and fivepence ($\pounds 3$ 14s. 5d.) per centum.

(4) No moneys shall be borrowed under the consent contained in the said Order in Council after the expiration of three (3) years from the date thereof.
