ADDENDUM, June, 1947, to the New Zealand Formulary:—

## NEW ZEALAND FORMULARY, PART 2

Clause 2 is hereby amended by adding at the end of subclause (1) thereof the following words—

"Provided that, except where a container and its contents are priced under these rules as an integral unit, no payment shall be made from the fund in respect of a glass container supplied pursuant to a second or subsequent order under any particular medical prescription."

This amendment shall take effect from 1st August, 1947.
