The Servicemen's Settlement and Land Sales Act, 1943.—Notice declaring Land taken for the Settlement of Discharged Servicemen

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 24 of the Servicemen's Settlement and Land Sales Act, 1943, notice was given of the intention of the Minister of Lands to take under Part II of the said Act the lands described in the Schedule hereto, and a copy of the said notice was published in the New Zealand Gazette No. 23 on the 1st day of May, 1947, at page 519:

And whereas no objection was made in the manner prescribed by the said Act.

And whereas the said land is not the land of any serviceman who is for the time being serving outside New Zealand in any of His Majesty's Forces or in any British ship:
Now, therefore, the Minister of Lands, acting in pursuance of section 27 of the said Act, doth hereby declare that the lands described in the said Schedule are taken for the settlement of discharged servicemen, and hereby specifies the 1st day of July, 1947, as the date on which the said lands shall be deemed to be vested in His Majesty the King.

#### SCHEDULE

#### WELLINGTON LAND DISTRICT

Wellington Land District

All that area situate in Blocks IX, XIII, and XIV, Rangitoto Survey District, containing by admeasurement two hundred and forty-eight (248) acres three (3) roods and five (5) perches, more or less, being part Sections 34, 34a, 2 of 38, and 44, Rangitikei District, and being also Lots 7 and 8 on a plan deposited in the office of the District Land Registrar at Wellington, numbered 4673, and being all the land comprised and described in certificate of title, Vol. 366, folio 88 (Wellington Registry).

Also all that area situate in Blocks V and VI, Koitiata Survey District, and Blocks IX and XIII, Rangitoto Survey District, containing by admeasurement nine hundred and seventy-one (971) acres and twenty-eight (28) perches, more or less, being parts of Sections 44 and 45 and parts of Blocks CXL, CXLII, CXLIV, CXLVI, and CXLVIII, Rangitikei District, and being also Lots 11, 12, 13, and 16 on a plan deposited in the office of the District Land Registrar at Wellington, numbered 4674, and being all the land comprised and described in certificate of title, Vol. 417, folio 96 (Wellington Registry).
