Settlement Land in Canterbury Land District proclaimed to be Ordinary Crown Land

WHEREAS by section forty-nine of the Land for Settlements Act, 1925, as amended by subsection one of section ten of the Land Laws Amendment Act, 1935, it is enacted that the Governor-General may by Proclamation declare any settlement land to be, *inter alia*, ordinary Crown land available for disposal under the Land Act, 1924: And whereas the land described in the Schedule hereto is settlement land within the meaning of the Lond for Settlements

And whereas the land described in the Isoledule hereas is settlement land within the meaning of the Land for Settlements Act, 1925, and it is deemed expedient that the said land shall cease to be settlement land and become ordinary Crown land available for disposal under the Land Act, 1924:

Now, therefore, in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities so conferred upon me by the aforesaid section forty-nine, amended as aforesaid, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that from and after the date of the gazetting hereof the land described in the Schedule hereto whell be achiever for the land described in the Schedule hereto Act, 1924.

#### SCHEDULE

ALL that area containing by admeasurement 45 acres, more or less, being part Section 11, Lees Valley Settlement, situated in Block VII, Upper Ashley Survey District, and bounded as follows: Towards the north-west by Rural Section 36843, 2685-0 links; towards the east generally by a public road, 253-7 links, 250-8 links, 630-2 links, 979-0 links, 539-6 links, 877-6 links, and 290-0 links; and towards the south-west generally by a 1 chain road reserved along the Whistler River. Amending a Proclamation setting apart Crown Land in Auckland Land District for the Purposes of Part I of the Housing Act, 1919

WHEREAS by a Proclamation dated the first day of April, one thousand nine hundred and forty-seven, and published in the *Gazette* of the tenth day of that month (hereinafter referred to as the said Proclamation), an area of Crown land in the Auckland Land District was set apart for the purposes of Part I of the Hausing Act 1010 in terms of putting for the interview.

Auckland Land District was set apart for the purposes of Part I of the Housing Act, 1919, in terms of section nine of the said Act : And whereas an error was made in the description of the land in the Schedule to the said Proclamation, and it is expedient that the error should be rectified : Now, therefore, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon me by the Housing Act, 1919, do hereby amend the said Proclamation by substituting the description of the land set forth in the Schedule hereto for the description of the land set forth in the Schedule to the said Proclamation.
