PURSUANT to section one hundred and twenty-eight of the Public Works Act, 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby approve of the following resolution passed by the Waipawa Borough Council on the twenty-third day of January, one thousand nine hundred and forty-seven, viz.:-

"The Waipawa Borough Council, being the local authority having control of the streets in the Borough of Waipawa, by resolution declares that the provisions of section one hundred and twenty-eight of the Public Works Act, 1928, shall not apply to the north-western side of the portion of Rose Street adjoining all that parcel of land containing five (5) acres, more or less, situate in the Borough of Waipawa, being part Block 56, Patangata Crown Grant District, and all the land comprised in and described by Certificate of Title, H.B. Volume 75, folio 280, limited as to parcels";

subject to the condition that no building or part of a building shall at any time be erected on the land fronting the north-western side of the portion of Rose Street (described in the Schedule hereto) within a distance of thirty-three feet from the centre-line of the said portion of street.
