A PROCLAMATION

In pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the First Schedule hereto is hereby taken for the purposes of the East Coast Main Trunk Railway (Gisborne southwards), and that the land described in the Second Schedule hereto is hereby taken for road-diversion in the Second Schedule hereto is hereby taken for road-diversion in connection therewith.

FIRST SCHEDULE FOR RAILWAY

APPROXIMATE area of the piece of land taken: 1 rood 10 perches. Being part road in Proclamation 230, formerly part No. 1 of Matawhero B or 5 Block; coloured neutral tint.

SECOND SCHEDULE

FOR ROAD-DIVERSION

APPROXIMATE area of the piece of land taken: 24.4 perches. Being part Railway land in Proclamation 230, formerly road; coloured green.

All being situated in Block II, Turanganui Survey District, Cook County. (S.O. 984, blue.)

Allocating Portion of Railway Land at Repongaere for Road Purposes

W HEREAS the land described in the Schedule hereto forms part of land taken for the purposes of the East Coast Main Trunk Railway (Gisborne southwards), and it is considered desirable to allocate such land to the purposes of a road:

Now, therefore, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by section two hundred and twenty-six of the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling 1928, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, do hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto shall, upon the publication hereof in the New Zealand Gazette, become a road, and that the said road shall be under the control of the Cook County Council, and shall be maintained by the said Council in like manner as other public highways are controlled and maintained by the said Council.

APPROXIMATE area of the piece of land: 3 roods 25 perches. Being part Railway land in Proclamation 291, and being formerly part of Section 80.

Situated in Block III, Patutahi Survey District, Cook County. (S.O. 1129, blue.)
