A PROCLAMATION

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby taken for railway purposes.

SCHEDULE

ALL that parcel of land containing 28 perches, more or less, being part of Section 174, City of Nelson, and being all the land comprised and described in Certificate of Title, Volume 42, folio 123 (Nelson Land Registry).

A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to the Public Works Act, 1928, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the additional land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby taken for a public school and shall vest in the Education Board of the District of Auckland as from the date hereinafter mentioned; and I do also declare that this Proclamation shall take effect on and after the eleventh day of August, one thousand nine hundred and forty-seven.

APPROXIMATE area of the piece of additional land taken: 2 roods. Being part Lot 3 (D.P. 14521 Ak.), part Allotment 324 of Section 2, Town of Opotiki.

PURSUANT to the Public Works Act, 1928, and section thirty of the Finance Act (No. 2), 1945, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the First and Second Schedules hereto is hereby taken for better utilization; and I do also declare that this Proclamation shall take effect on and after the eleventh day of August, one thousand nine hundred and forty-seven.
