C (s) 2/13/26	Electrical fittings, viz. :— Lampholders	84	Adaptors which incorporate a lampholder, whether or not incorporating a switch.
C (s) 2/13/26	Wall plugs	84	"Tap-on" wall plugs, being wall plugs physically incorporating sockets for the insertion of further wall plugs to enable two or more leads of flex to be taken from the one power-point socket.
C (s) 2/11	Electric motors	84	Fuses, fuse boxes, voltage regulators, and cut-outs for electric generators for motor-vehicles (or any combination thereof).
