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Allocating Railway Land to the Purposes of Road in Block XVII, Lowry Peaks Survey District

#### [L.S.] B. C. FREYBERG, Governor-General A PROCLAMATION

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Public Works Act, 1928, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard
Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New
Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the land which is
described in the Schedule hereto (and which was reserved for railway
purposes and is not now required for that purpose) shall, upon the
publication hereof in the New Zealand Gazette, become road, and
that such road shall be maintained by the Cheviot County Council
in like manner as other public highways are controlled and maintained
by the said Council.

### SCHEDULE

Approximate area of the piece of land dealt with : 3 roods 1 perch. Being railway land in Proclamation No. 230.

Situated in Block XVII, Lowry Peaks Survey District (Canterbury R.D.). (S.O. 7865.)
