## WELLINGTON CITY COUNCIL

## RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

The Wellington City (Mercer Street) Land Purchase Renewal Loan, 1948, of £40,000

THE following resolution was duly passed at a meeting of the Wellington City Council held on the 1st day of September, 1947, viz:—

"In pursuance and in exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the provisions of the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, and its amendments, and of all other Acts, powers, and authorities enabling it in that behalf, the Wellington City Council doth hereby resolve as follows:—

"That, for the purpose of providing the interest, sinking fund, and other charges on a special loan of forty thousand pounds (£40,000), to be known as the 'Wellington City (Mercer Street) Land Purchase Renewal Loan, 1948,' authorized to be raised by the Wellington City Council under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose of redeeming, to the extent that sinking funds are insufficient, the Wellington City (Mercer Street) Land Purchase Loan, 1938, which matures on the 1st day of February, 1948, the Wellington City Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of forty eight-hundredths of a penny (40/800d.) in the pound on the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property within the whole of the City of Wellington; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of April in each year during the currency of such loan, being a period of fifteen (15) years from the 1st day of February, 1948, or until the loan is fully paid off."
