any of that month, temporarily reserved under the authority of the said Act for recreation purposes: Now, therefore, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Frey-berg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon me by the said Act, do hereby permanently reserve the land described in the Schedule hereto for recreation purposes for which purpose the said land was so temporarily reserved as aforesaid.
