B. C. FREYBERG, Governor-General [L.S.] A PROCLAMATION

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby taken for the purposes of the Kaipara-Waikato Railway.

SCHEDULE

ALL that parcel of land containing 6 acres 0 roods 13 perches, more or less, being part of the land on Deposited Plan No. 8184, and being portion of Allotments 46 and 46A of the Parish of Pukete, and being all the land comprised and described in Certificate of Title, Volume 719, folio 124 (Auckland Land Registry).

Also all that parcel of land containing 69 acres 0 roods 31·1 perches, more or less, being Lots 1 and 2 on Deposited Plan No. 16377, and being Allotments 44 and 45 of the Parish of Pukete, and being all the land comprised and described in Certificate of Title, Volume 657, folio 215 (Auckland Land Registry).
