*Road and Street Loan, 1946, £5,000*

**I**N pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1936, and every other power in that behalf enabling it, the Warkworth Town Board hereby resolves as follows:—

"That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of (£5,000) five thousand pounds, authorized to be raised by the Warkworth Town Board under the above-mentioned Act, for sealing portions of roads and streets within the Town District, the said Warkworth Town Board hereby makes and levies a special rate of ( $\frac{13}{16}$ d.) thirteen-sixteenths pence in the (£) pound upon the rateable value of all the rateable property of the whole of the Warkworth Town District; and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly on the first day of April in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twelve years or until the loan is fully paid off."
