Additional Land taken for a Hospital in the City of Auckland

[L.S.] B. C. FREYBERG, Governor-General A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to the Public Works Act, 1928, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the additional land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby taken for a hospital and shall vest in the Auckland Hospital Board as from the date hereinafter mentioned; and I do also declare that this Proclamation shall take effect on and after the seventeenth day of November, one thousand nine hundred and forty-seven.

SCHEDULE

APPROXIMATE area of the piece of additional land taken: 1 rood. Being part of Allotment 17, Section 18, Suburbs of Auckland, bounded as appears on D.P. 2690, reserving, however, to the owners for the time being of Lots 8, 9, and 10 of the said Allotment 17 a right to drain particularly specified in Transfer 28907, and being the whole of the land comprised and described in Certificate of Title, Volume 110, folio 159 (Auckland Land Registry).
