RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

Traffic Signals Loan, 1946

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by section 21 of the Local Legislation Act, 1946, and the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Auckland City Council hereby resolves as follows:—

“That, for the purpose of providing interest and other charges on a loan of £34,000, authorized to be raised by the Auckland City Council under the above-mentioned Acts, for the purpose of purchasing and installing traffic-signal equipment at ten intersections in the City of Auckland, the said Auckland City Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of one-third of one penny in the pound upon the rateable value of all rateable property (on the basis of the annual value) of the Auckland City, comprising the whole of the City of Auckland; and that the said special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and shall be payable yearly on the 1st day of June in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of ten years or until the loan is fully paid off.”

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

Parks and Reserves Loan, 1946

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Municipal Corporations Act, 1933, the Physical Welfare and Recreation Act, 1937, and the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Auckland City Council hereby resolves as follows:—

“That, for the purpose of providing interest and other charges on a loan of £144,500, authorized to be raised by the Auckland City Council under the above-mentioned Acts, for the purpose of acquiring areas for development as parks and reserves and erecting buildings thereon, and developing and erecting buildings on parks and reserves already owned by the Council, the said Auckland City Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of two-thirds of one penny in the pound upon the rateable value of all rateable property (on the basis of the annual value) of the Auckland City, comprising the whole of the City of Auckland; and that the said special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and shall be payable yearly on the 1st day of June in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being for a period of twenty-five years or until the loan is fully paid off.”
