PURSUANT to section one hundred and twenty-eight of the Public Works Act, 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby approve of the following resolution passed by the Gore Borough Council on the thirtieth day of September, one thousand nine hundred and forty-six, viz. :—

“That the Gore Borough Council, being the local authority having control of the streets in the Borough of Gore, by resolution declares that the provisions of section one hundred and twenty-eight of the Public Works Act, 1928, shall not apply to the southern side of the portion of Duke Street adjoining Lots 7, 8, D.P. 29, being part Section 35, Block XVI, Town of Gore, and comprised in Certificate of Title, Volume 65, folio 181”;

subject to the condition that no building or part of a building shall at any time be erected on the land fronting the southern side of the portion of Duke Street (described in the Schedule hereto) within a distance of thirty-three feet from the centre-line of the said portion of street.

PURSUANT to section one hundred and twenty-eight of the Public Works Act, 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby approve of the following resolution passed by the Tuapeka County Council on the fourteenth day of October, one thousand nine hundred and forty-six, in so far as it affects the sides and portions of road described in the Schedule hereto, viz. :—

“That the Tuapeka County Council, being the local authority having control of the roads in the County of Tuapeka, by resolution declares that the provisions of section one hundred and twenty-eight of the Public Works Act, 1928, shall not apply to the road on the northern and eastern sides of Section 20, Block I, Benger Survey District”;
