Crown Land set apart as a Permanent State Forest

A PROCLAMATION

BY virtue and in exercise of the powers and authorities conferred upon me by section eighteen of the Forests Act, 1921-22, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby set apart the Crown land described in the Schedule hereto as a permanent State forest.

SCHEDULE

NELSON LAND DISTRICT.—NELSON CONSERVANCY

ALL that area in the Nelson Land District, Inangahua County, containing by admeasurement 592 acres 1 rood, more or less, and being part of Sections 1 and 3, Block XVI, Mawhera-iti Survey District, and bounded generally as follows: Commencing at the westernmost corner of Section 3 aforesaid; thence towards the north-west by provisional State forest (*Gazette*, 1920, page 2112), and by Section 9, Block XVI aforesaid, to the Snowy River Road; thence towards the north-east by that road and by the Township of Hukawai to the easternmost corner of Section 1 aforesaid; thence towards the south-east and south-west by provisional State forest (*Gazette* 1920, page 2112) to the point of commencement; excepting thereout part of Section 1, containing 49 acres, more or less, and being part of provisional State forest (*Gazette*, 1930 page 3123). As the same is more particularly delineated on plan No. 120/41, deposited in the Head Office of the State Forest Service at Wellington, and thereon bordered red.
