The Servicemen's Settlement and Land Sales Act, 1943.—Notice declaring Lands taken for the Settlement of Discharged Servicemen

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 24 of the Servicemen's Settlement and Land Sales Act, 1943, notice was given of the intention of the Minister of Lands to take under Part II of the said Act the lands described in the Schedule hereto, and a copy of the said notice was published in the *New Zealand Gazette* No. 46 on the 21st day of August, 1947, at page 1022:

And whereas an objection was made by the owner in the manner prescribed by the said Act, objecting to the taking of the said lands:

And whereas the Minister of Lands did not revoke his notice of intention to take the said lands:

And whereas the Land Sales Committee to which the objection was referred made an order disallowing such objection and determining the lands to be suitable for the settlement of a discharged serviceman or discharged servicemen:

And whereas no appeal from the said order was made within the time prescribed by the Act or within any further time allowed by the Court:
