

Arai Parish, crossing the public road which intersects the last-mentioned allotment, along the south-eastern boundaries of Allotments 18 and 15, Arai Parish, the abutment of a public road, the south-eastern boundaries of Allotments 5 and 4, Arai Parish, the abutment of a public road, along the south-eastern boundaries of Allotments 3 and 2, Arai Parish, crossing the public road which intersects the last-mentioned allotment, along the south-eastern boundary of Allotment 1, Arai Parish, and along a right line being that boundary produced to the sea-coast; thence south-easterly along the sea-coast to the northernmost corner of Lot 3 aforementioned, being the point of commencement.

"The boundaries of the Arai, Kaipara, Kourawhero, Matakana, Omaha, Puhoi, and Tgūhoa Ridings shall remain as heretofore.
