## RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE AS SECURITY FOR LOAN

*Redemption Loan, 1947, £9,129*

"That, for the purpose of providing the principal, interest, and other charges on a loan of £9,129 (to be known as the 'Redemption Loan, 1947'), authorized to be raised by the Wairere Electric-power Board under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose of redeeming the outstanding liability in respect of the following loans—(1) Electricity Loan No. 3, 1936, £17,000, portion, £5,000; (2) Special Loan, 1937, £3,000; (3) Reticulation Loan, 1938, £14,000, portion, £5,000; (4) Reticulation Loan, 1938, £14,000, portion, £2,000—the said Wairere Electric-power Board hereby makes and levies a special rate of  $\frac{1}{2}$  of one penny in the pound on the rateable unimproved value of all rateable property in Wairere Electric-power Board's Rating Area; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of May in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of eleven years or until the loan is fully paid off."
