*Declaring Portion of Railway Land at Waiaroa to be Crown Land*

A PROCLAMATION

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby declare the land described in the Schedule hereto to be Crown land subject to the Land Act, 1924.

## SCHEDULE

APPROXIMATE area of the piece of land: 1 rood 2.3 perches. Being part Matamata South 693B, in Certificate of Title, Volume 50, folio 278.

Situated in Block XIII, Wairere Survey District, Matamata County. (S.O. 33532.)

In the Auckland Land District; as the same is more particularly delineated on the plan marked L.O. 9262, deposited in the office of the Minister of Railways at Wellington, and thereon coloured orange.
