NOTICE OF INTENTION TO TAKE LAND UNDER THE PUBLIC WORKS ACT, 1928

In the matter of the Counties Act, 1920, and the Public Works Act, 1928.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Waitemata County Council proposes, under the provisions of the above-mentioned Acts, to execute a certain public work—namely, the realignment and reconstruction of a portion of the Beach Road Main Highway passing through or adjoining the several pieces of land referred to hereunder in the Takapuna Riding of the County—and for the purpose of such public work the lands described in the Schedule hereto are required to be taken: And notice is hereby further given that plans of the lands so required to be taken are deposited in the public office of the Clerk of the said Council, situated at the Council Chambers, 1 Princes Street, Auckland, and are open for inspection (without fee) by all persons during ordinary office hours.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Mayor, Councillors, and Burgesses of the Borough of Levin (hereinafter referred to as the Corporation) proposes to take for waterworks an easement over the lands described in the Schedule hereto, vesting in the said Corporation full and free right and liberty forever to maintain without hindrance a line of water-pipes through and under each of the said pieces of land, and to use such water-pipes for the purpose of conveying water, and granting unto the Corporation full and free right and liberty for itself, its surveyors, workmen, agents, employees, servants, and licensees from time to time and at all times to open up, remove, or replace the said water-pipes as often as occasion shall require for the purpose of inspecting, cleansing, amending, renewing, or repairing the said pipes and/or maintaining the same in good and satisfactory repair, order, and condition.
