The Crematorium Loan, 1946, £55,000

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Municipal Corporations Act, 1933, the Cemeteries Act, 1908, the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Local Government Loans Board Act, 1926, and regulations thereunder, and of all other powers thereunto enabling it, the Auckland City Council hereby resolves as follows:—
