NOTICE is hereby given that the Napier Borough Council proposes to execute a certain public work—namely, the construction of a sewer rising main or mains from Marewa Park to the Napier Borough sewage-collecting tanks at Hardinge Road, Port Ahuriri, Napier—and that for the purpose of such public work the easement set forth in the First Schedule hereto is required to be taken over the lands described in the Second Schedule hereto.

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## THAMES VALLEY ELECTRIC-POWER BOARD

## RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

IN pursuance and in exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, and of all other powers (if any) it thereunto enabling, the Thames Valley Electric-power Board hereby resolves as follows:—

“That, for the purpose of providing for the payment of principal, interest, and other charges on the Redemption Loan, 1948, of £20,000, authorized to be raised by the Thames Valley Electric-power Board under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose of purchasing, constructing, and providing electric works, as defined in the Electric-power Boards Act, 1925, in order to supply and to extend the supply of electricity within the whole of the Thames Valley Electric-power District, the said Board hereby makes and levies a special rate of one-fortieth of a penny ( $\frac{1}{40}$ d.) in the pound on the rateable value (on the basis of the capital value) of all rateable property in the Thames Valley Electric-power District, as defined in the Proclamation proclaiming the said district appearing in the *New Zealand Gazette* of the 8th January, 1920, at page 12, excepting the area excluded by Proclamation appearing in the *New Zealand Gazette* of the 6th September, 1923, at page 2318; and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly on the 31st day of March in each year during the currency of such loan, being a period of fifteen (15) years or until the loan is fully paid off.”

## CHRISTCHURCH DRAINAGE BOARD

## RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

*Drainage Loan No. 2, 1947, £10,000*

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Christchurch Drainage Board hereby resolves as follows:—

“That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of ten thousand pounds (£10,000), authorized to be raised by the Christchurch Drainage Board under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose of reconstructing Horner's Drain and the Ferry Road storm-water sewer outlet in concrete, the said Christchurch Drainage Board hereby makes and levies a special rate of three five-hundred-and-twelfths of a penny ( $\frac{3}{512}$ d.) in the pound upon the capital rateable value of all rateable property in the Christchurch Drainage District as at present constituted, and as may be extended or reconstituted from time to time; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly on the 31st day of March in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of fifteen years or until the loan is fully paid off.”
