Altering the Boundaries of the Wanganui-Rangitikei Electric-power District

A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to the Electric-power Boards Act, 1925, I, Lieu-tenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby alter the boundaries of the Wanganui-Rangitikei Electric-power District so as to include the area described in the Schedule hereto.

## SCHEDULE

ALL that area in the Wellington Land District comprising portion of the Waimarino County and bounded by a line commencing at Trig. A (Totem), being a point on the southern boundary of that county, and proceeding westerly and southerly and westerly along that boundary, as described in *New Zealand Gazette*, 1930, page 2096, to the western boundary of Moawhango Survey District; thence northerly along that boundary of Moawhargo Survey District, there northerly along that boundary to its intersection with a right line between Trig. Tunutara and Trig. A (Totem); thence easterly along that right line to Trig. A (Totem), the point of commencement. As the same is more particularly delineated on the plan marked S.H.D. 34, deposited in the office of the Minister in Charge of the State Hydro-electric Department, and thereon outlined in green.
