

Proclaiming a Tribal District under the Maori Social and Economic Advancement Act, 1945

A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to section six of the Maori Social and Economic Advancement Act, 1945, and to subsection one of section fifteen of the Maori Purposes Act, 1947, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby declare the parts of New Zealand described in the Schedule hereto to be a tribal district for the purpose of the said Maori Social and Economic Advancement Act, 1945, and do hereby assign to the said district the name "Rotorua Borough Tribal District."

SCHEDULE

THE ROTORUA BOROUGH TRIBAL DISTRICT

ALL that area in the Auckland Land District, being the Borough of Rotorua, as described in the *New Zealand Gazette* of 1946, at page 1085.

Amending a Proclamation taking Land for Railway Purposes in Block XIII, Waiho Survey District

A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to the Public Works Act, 1928, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby revoke the Schedule to the Proclamation dated the eleventh day of May, one thousand nine hundred and forty, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* No. 43 of the sixteenth day of the same month at page 1055, taking land for railway purposes in Block XIII, Waiho Survey District, and in lieu thereof do hereby proclaim and declare that the land taken for railway purposes shall be that described in the Schedule hereto.

PURSUANT to section thirty-five of the Public Works Act, 1928, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby declare the land described in the Schedule hereto to be Crown land subject to the Land Act, 1924.

PURSUANT to the Public Works Act, 1928, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the Crown land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby set apart for road; and I do also declare that this Proclamation shall take effect on and after the twenty-eighth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and forty-eight.
