1. This Order may be cited as Price Order No. 902, and shall be read together with and deemed part of Price Order No. 899* (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order).
2. This Order shall come into force on the 8th day of July, 1948.
3. The principal Order is hereby amended by omitting from clause 3 the words “Industrial Efficiency Act, 1936”, and substituting the words “Fisheries Amendment Act, 1945”.

PRELIMINARY

1. This Order may be cited as Price Order No. 903, and shall come into force on the 12th day of July, 1948.
- (1) Price Order No. 745* is hereby revoked.
- (2) The revocation of the said Order shall not affect the liability of any person for any offence in relation thereto committed before the coming into force of this Order.

APPLICATION OF THIS ORDER

3. This Order applies only with respect to boot and floor polishes manufactured by the Nugget Polish Company of New Zealand, Limited, and marketed under the trade name of “Nugget,” “Poliflor,” “Cardinal,” “Rolfes,” or “Tip Top.”
