## SPRINGS-ELLESMERE ELECTRIC-POWER BOARD

## RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, and of all other powers it thereunto enabling, the Springs-Ellesmere Electric-power Board hereby resolves as follows:—

"That, for the purpose of providing the interest, sinking fund, and other charges on a loan of £30,000, known as the 'No. 7 Reticulation Loan, 1946,' authorized pursuant to section 15 of the Finance Act (No. 2), 1936, to be raised by the Springs-Ellesmere Electric-power Board under the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, for the purpose of the further reticulation of the Springs-Ellesmere Electric-power District, the said the Springs-Ellesmere Electric-power Board hereby makes and levies a special rate of one-fifteenth ( $\frac{1}{15}$ ) of a penny in the pound upon the rateable value (on the basis of the capital value) of all rateable property of the Springs-Ellesmere Electric-power District, comprising the whole of the counties of Ellesmere, Springs, and Papanui, parts of the counties of Selwyn, Halswell, and Malvern, and the town districts of Leeston and Southbridge; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly on the 31st day of March in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty-five years or until the loan is fully paid off."
