Exemption Order under the Transport Legislation Emergency Regulations 1940

PURSUANT to the Transport Legislation Emergency Regulations 1940,* the Minister of Transport doth hereby order and declare that the provisions of clause (4A) of Regulation 5, and the requirement in subparagraph (b) of paragraph 1 in Form No. 5 of the Motor-drivers Regulations 1940, so far as they relate to the driving of a motor-omnibus, shall not apply to the person hereinafter mentioned, but in lieu thereof the following provision shall apply:—

A motor-driver's licence issued under the Motor-drivers Regulations 1940 to J. H. Wyatt, of Dargaville, may authorize him to drive a motor-omnibus for the purpose of carrying the school-children and teachers of the Arapohue School, Dargaville, but shall not authorize him to drive a motor-omnibus for any other purpose.

Approval of Application by Nelson City Council for Declaration of a Zone of Parking Restriction
