A PROCLAMATION

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby taken for the purposes of the Midland Railway.

A PROCLAMATION

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities vested in me by the Public Works Act, 1928, and of every other power and authority in anywise enabling me in this behalf, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby revoke so much of the Proclamation dated the twenty-eighth day of October, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-five, and published in the *New Zealand Gazette* of the same year at page 1277, taking land for the purposes of the Waitaki-Bluff Railway—namely, ballast-pit at Balclutha—as affects the land described in the Schedule hereto.

A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to the Public Works Act, 1928, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the leasehold estate in the land described in the Schedule hereto, held from the Maori Trustee by Adolphus Anderson Shannon, of Greymouth, Baker, under and by virtue of Lease No. 3427, Westland Registry, is hereby taken for a police-station; and I do also declare that this Proclamation shall take effect on and after the twenty-sixth day of July, one thousand nine hundred and forty-eight.
