The references in this part of the New Zealand Formulary to the First Schedule to the Rules of Prescription Pricing shall, where applicable, be deemed to be to the Prescription Pricing Supplement 1948/3, issued by the Pharmacy Plan Industrial Committee. The Servicemen's Settlement and Land Sales Act, 1943.declaring Land taken for the Settlement of a Discharged Service-

WHEREAS an application has been made for the consent of the Land Sales Court to a transaction which relates to the land described in the Schedule hereto and to which Part III

Now, therefore, the Minister of Lands, acting in pursuance of section 51 of the said Act, doth hereby declare that the said land is taken for the settlement of a discharged serviceman, and hereby specifies the 30th day of August, 1948, as the date on which the said land shall be deemed to be vested in His Majesty the King.
