1938	Dredgeburn (glacier)	Humboldt	Otago	At head of Dredgeburn River.
1941	Dryad (island)	South Cape	Southland	In Port Pegasus, Stewart Island.
1944	Dumgree (trig.)	Taylor Pass	Marlborough	Block XIV.
1933	Earl (mountains)	Eglinton and Clinton	Southland	A range running north and south on the east side of the north arm of Lake Te Anau.
1932	Earle (mountain)	Torlesse	Canterbury	7,950 ft. On the Two Thumb Range.
1938	Earnslaw (glacier)	Dart and Earnslaw	Otago	On the south-east face of Earnslaw Massif.
1940	East (peak)	Humboldt	Otago	On the Cosmos Range between Brideburn and Beansburn Rivers.
1931	Easter (glacier)	Torlesse	Canterbury	Tributary of the Classen Glacier.
1941	Eastern (bay)	Paterson	Southland	On the Neck, Stewart Island.
1943	East Hawdon (stream)	Hawdon	Canterbury	Block V. Large tributary flowing in from the east.
1940	Eblis (gorge)	Tyndall	Westland	On the Adams River near Speculation Hill.
1925	Edgecumbe (mountain)	Upper Rangitaiki	Auckland	The Maori name Putauaki is the official name.
1925	Edgecumbe (railway-station)	Upper Rangitaiki	Auckland	This name replaces Rangitaiki.
1938	Edwards (glacier)	Waitangi-Taona	Westland	Running north-west into the Times Glacier between Mounts Green and Coronet.
1941	Edwardson (cape)	Paterson	Southland	Otherwise known as East Cape.
1933	Eglinton (mountain and river)	Eglinton	Southland	Mountain on Earl Range. River rises east of this range and flows into Lake Te Anau.
1936	Elcho (glacier)	Ward	Otago	At the head of the north branch of the Elcho Creek.
1936	Elcho (pass)	Ward	Otago	On the Main Divide between Mounts Hickson and Baker.
1945	End (trig.)	Pohue	Hawkes Bay	Block XIV.
1935	Engineer (pass)	Cook	Canterbury	Between Mounts Tasman and Lendenfeld.
1941	Eparaima (block)	Kaiwhata	Wellington	Block III. Not "Eperaima."
1945	Epuni (railway-station)	Belmont	Wellington	Block IX.
1934	*Erewhon (col)	Ramsay	Canterbury	Unmapped. Upper Rakaia District.
1934	*Erewhon (peak)	Ramsay	Canterbury	Upper Rakaia District.
1939	Espinosa (point)	Fiord County	Southland	Formerly Woodhead. In Doubtful Sound.
1943	Exeter (peak)	Sinclair	Canterbury	On the Two Thumb Range, West of Mount Alma.
1928	Fairy (spring)	Rotorua	Auckland	The Maori name is Te-Punaa-Tuhoe.
1938	False (col)	Humboldt	Otago	Uncrossable. Between Naïsen and Johansen Peaks.
1940	Farrell (peak)	Humboldtside	Otago	On the same ridge as the Trinity Peaks, and lying to the west of them.
1943	Farquharson (saddle)	Brownings Pass	Westland	Between Gifford and Farquharson. Block VI.
1938	*Fastness (peak)	Matukituki	Otago	About three miles and a half east of Mount Aspiring.
1939	Febrero (point)	Fiord County	Southland	South head of Doubtful Sound.
1943	Ferguson (point)	Kaero	North Auckland	Block II.
1944	Ferdunlaw (hill)	Aparima	Southland	Block VII.
1939	Ferniehurst (railway-station)	Hawkswood	Canterbury	South Island Main Trunk Railway.
1945	Ferrar (peak)	Clyde	Canterbury	On Cloudy Peak Range. Block IX.
1938	Ferrier (glacier)	Forbes	Otago	On the east face of Mount Lydia.
1938	*Ferrier (peak)	Forbes	Otago	On the Main Divide, south-west of Mount Ian.
1929	Field (peak)	Eritonga	Wellington	West of Mount Hector, Tararua Range.
1938	*Fiery (col)	Humboldt	Otago	Between Mount Tantalus and Fiery Peak.
1938	*Fiery (peak)	Humboldt	Otago	On the west spur of Mount Tantalus.
