1938	*Rob Roy (peak)	Matukituki	Otago	At the head of the Rob Roy Glacier.
1932	Roche (pass)	Katrine	Canterbury	At the head of the Cox River.
1938	Roderick (peak)	Waitangi-Taona	Westland	On the Maximilian Range north of Elie de Beaumont.
1941	Roger (head)	Anglem	Southland	On Codfish Island.
1943	Roimata (point)	Opuawhanga	North Auckland	Block VI. In place of Kohinatupou and Kohinutopu.
1941	Romanga (stream)	Aroha	Auckland	Block VI. Not "Romunga."
1935	Rose (peak)	Cook	Canterbury	On the spur from Haeckel Peak between Dixon and Manner-ing Glaciers.
1928	Rotoatua	Rotorua	Auckland	Not "Roto-atua."
1928	Rotokawa (post-office)	Rotoiti	Auckland	At the lake of the same name.
1936	Rotongaru (lake)	Rangiriri	Auckland	This is the correct name of the lake near Huntly known as "Wahi."
1941	Rotootahe	Whangara	Gisborne	Block III. Not "Roto-o-tahi."
1941	Rotopounamu (lake)	Mahanga	Hawkes Bay	Block II. Not "Rotopanamu."
1943	Rover (saddle)	Minchin	Canterbury	Block IV.
1932	Row (mountain)	Minchin	Canterbury	Near Cox River, a tributary of the Waimakariri.
1934	Royal (creek)	Hunter	Otago	The biggest tributary of the east branch of the Hunter River from the Huxley Range.
1941	Ruakituri (stream)	Mohaka	Hawkes Bay	Block XII. Not "Ruakuturi."
1943	Ruakoura (point)	Whangaruru	North Auckland	Block II. Not "Ruakora."
1930	Ruamahanga (river)	Wairarapa	Wellington	Not "Ruamahunga."
1941	Ruapae (trig.)	Tararua	Wellington	Block VIII. Not "Ruapai."
1940	Ruautuhenua	Titirangi	North Auckland	Waitakere Ranges. Not "Ruotewhenua."
1928	Ruapehu (mountain)	Ruapehu	Wellington	This name refers to the highest peak and the mountain mass as a whole.
1943	Rugged (peak)	Bealey	Canterbury	Block IV. Next to Trudge Col.
1938	Ruth (stream)	Matukituki	Otago	Flows into the east branch of the Matukituki River north of Kitchener River.
1945	Salisbury (trig.)	Maraekakaho	Hawkes Bay	Block I.
1943	Scarface (mountain)	Minchin	Canterbury	Block IX.
1943	Sceptre (peak)	Tyndall	Canterbury	Block II.
1940	Sealey (glacier)	Humboldtside and Forbeside	Otago	Northern Olivine Range, flowing west to become branch of Pyke River.
1943	Sentinel, The (peak)	Ramsay	Canterbury	Block X. On a subsidiary range of the Armoury Range.
1938	Serpentine (range)	Humboldtside	Otago	In the Humboldt Mountains.
1929	Seymour (peak)	Torlesse	Canterbury	At the head of the Grey Glacier, a tributary of the Godley Glacier.
1943	Shark (island)	Whangaroa	North Auckland	Block III.
1938	Sir William (peak)	Forbes	Otago	One mile south-east of Mount Cerberus.
1933	Skelmorlie (peak)	Clinton	Southland	In Earl Mountains.
1938	*Slab Lookout	Hollyford	Otago	A conspicuous long slab slope directly above the junction of two headwaters of Stickup Creek.
1941	Smoky (beach)	Anglem	Southland	Stewart Island.
1943	Smooth (peak)	Bealey	Canterbury	Block IV. Next to Rugged Peak.
1934	*Smyth (glacier)	Hunter	Otago	Unmapped. At the headwaters of the Hunter River.
1934	*Snow Dome (peak)	Ramsay	Canterbury	Unmapped. In the Upper Rakaia District.
1945	Snowdrift (range)	Forbes	Otago	Between Whitbourn and Snowdrift Glaciers.
1945	*Snowman, The (peak)	Forbes	Otago	A heavily glaciated peak, the outermost on Snowdrift Range.
1945	Snow White (glacier)	Cascade	Otago	Feeding the Arawhata River.
1938	Solution (col)	Humboldt	Otago	Between Climax and Destiny Peaks, Humboldt Mountains.
1939	Soucis (cape)	Whangamoia	Nelson	Near Croixelles Harbour.
1945	South (peak)	Ramsay	Canterbury	Block XII. On the range between Mount Arrowsmith and Mount Potts.
1945	South Snowball (saddle)	Forbes	Otago	Between Mounts Delta and Pivot.
1941	South West (arm)	Paterson	Southland	Stewart Island. Also called Caerhowel Arm.
1941	Spar (cove)	South Cape	Southland	Stewart Island. Also known as Bens Bay.
1934	*Spearpoint (peak)	Ramsay	Canterbury	Unmapped. At the headwaters of the Rangitata and Rakaia Rivers.
