HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

WHEREAS by Order in Council made on the thirty-first day of March, one thousand nine hundred and forty-eight (hereinafter referred to as the said Order in Council), and subject to the determinations as to borrowing and repayment therein set out, consent was given to the raising in New Zealand by the Whangarei Borough Council (hereinafter referred to as the said local authority) of a loan of twenty thousand pounds (£20,000), to be known as "Sewerage Extension and Storm-water Drainage Loan, 1947" (hereinafter referred to as the said loan):

And whereas the authority conferred by the said Order in Council has not yet been exercised, and it is expedient to vary certain of the determinations aforesaid in respect of the said loan:

Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, and in pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities conferred on him by section eleven of the Local Government Loans Board Act, 1926, as set out in section twenty-nine of the Finance Act, 1932 (No. 2), and of all other powers and authorities enabling him in this behalf, doth hereby vary the determinations aforesaid in respect of the said loan by prescribing that in lieu of the raising of the said loan in four (4) equal portions of five thousand pounds (£5,000) each and the repayment of each such portion of five thousand pounds (£5,000) by half-yearly instalments in the half-years set out in the Schedule to the said Order in Council, as specified in clause three of the said Order in Council, the said loan shall be repaid by the half-yearly redemption of debentures in the half-years set out in the first column of the Schedule hereunder of the amounts stated opposite each such half-year in the second column of the said Schedule.
