DANNEVIRKE ELECTRIC-POWER BOARD

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

IN pursuance and exercise of the power vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, the Dannevirke Electric-power Board hereby resolves as follows:—

"That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of thirty thousand pounds (£30,000), authorized to be raised by the Dannevirke Electric-power Board under the above-mentioned Act, for the purpose of providing, constructing, and erecting extensions and additions to all the electrical distribution and reticulation of the Dannevirke Electric-power District, and provide tools, plant, buildings, land, and equipment for the same, as defined by the Electric-power Boards Act, 1925, and its amendments, the said Dannevirke Electric-power Board hereby makes and levies a special rate of sixteen one-hundredths of one penny (16/100d.) in the pound upon the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property of the Dannevirke Electric-power District, comprising the whole of the Dannevirke Electric-power District as defined in the Proclamation proclaiming the said district appearing in the *New Zealand Gazette* of the 11th day of August, 1921; and that the said special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly on the 31st day of March in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty years or until the loan is fully paid off."
