PURSUANT to the Public Works Act, 1928, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Bernard Cyril Freyberg, the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, do hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the First Schedule hereto is hereby taken for the development of water-power (Highbank Power Scheme); and I do also hereby proclaim and declare that an easement is hereby taken for the development of water-power over the land described in the Second Schedule hereto vesting in His Majesty the King full and free liberty, right, license, and authority in perpetuity to construct and use a right-of-way, with the right for His Majesty's servants, agents, and workmen from time to time and at all times hereafter to go, pass, and repass with or without horses or other animals or vehicles over the said land and to maintain, renew, repair, and keep open the said right-of-way, such right-of-way to be appurtenant to the land first described in the First Schedule hereto.
