HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL WHEREAS the Palmerstor North City Council (hereinafter called the said local authority), being desirous of raising a loan of four thousand five hundred pounds (£4,500), to be known as "Gasworks Gantry Loan, 1948" (hereinafter called the said loan), for the purpose of purchasing and erecting a coal gantry at the gasworks, has complied with the provisions of the Local Government Loans Board Act, 1926 (hereinafter called the said Act), and it is expedient that the precedent consent of the Governor-General in Council, as required by the said Act, should be given to the raising of the said loan : Now, therefore, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, and in pursuance and exercise of the said Act, as set out in section twenty-nine of the Finance Act, 1932 (No. 2), and of all other powers and autho-rities enabling him in this behalf, doth hereby consent to the raising in New Zealand by the said local authority of the said loan for the said purpose up to the amount of four thousand five hundred pounds

said purpose up to the amount of four thousand five hundred pounds (\$4,500), and in giving such consent doth hereby determine as follows

(1) The term for which the said loan or any part thereof may

(1) The term for which the said loan or any part thereof may be raised shall not exceed twenty (20) years.
(2) The rate of interest that may be paid in respect of the said loan or any part thereof shall be such as shall not produce to the lender or lenders a rate or rates exceeding three pounds five shillings (£3 5s.) per centum per annum.
(3) The said local authority shall, before raising the said loan or any part thereof, make provision for the repayment thereof by establishing a sinking fund under the Local Bodies' Loans Act, 1926, or under such other statutory enactment as may be applicable, and shall thereafter make payments to such sinking fund at intervals of not more than one year at a rate or rates per centum which shall be not less than three pounds fourteen shillings and fivepence (£3 14s. 5d.), such payments to be made in respect of every part of the said loan of any part thereofs or rates and on to repaid, the first day from which interest to the lender or lenders is computed on the said loan or any part thereefs or sized.
(4) The payment of interest and the repayment of principal in respect of the said loan shall be made in New Zealand.
(5) No amount payable as either interest or sinking fund in respect of the said loan shall be paid out of loan-money.
(6) The rate payable for brokerage, underwriting, and production of the respect of the rate payable of the rate or any part thereof or a rate or any part thereof so raised.

(6) The rate payable for brokerage, underwriting, and pro-curation fees in respect of the raising of the said loan or any part thereof shall not in the aggregate exceed one-half per centum of the amount raised.

(7) No moneys shall be borrowed under this consent after the expiration of two years from the date hereof.
