PURSUANT to the Public Works Act, 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby grant to David William Oxnam, of Murchison, Farmer (hereinafter referred to as the licensee), a licence subject to the conditions hereinafter set forth, to take and use from the Mole River (hereinafter referred to as the said stream) situated in Section 4s, Block IV, Matakitaki Survey District, in the Land District of Nelson, for the purposes hereinafter set forth, a stream of water not exceeding two cubic feet per second at any one time.

# CONDITIONS

# 1. Implied Conditions

The conditions directed to be implied in all licences by the Water-power Regulations 1934 and the Electrical Supply Regulations 1935 shall be incorporated in and shall form part of this licence, except in so far as the same may be inconsistent with the provisions hereof.

# 2. LICENCE SUBJECT TO REGULATIONS

This licence is issued under the Water-power Regulations 1934, and is subject thereto and to the Electrical Supply Regulations 1935, the Electrical Wiring Regulations 1935, and the Radio Interference Regulations 1934, and to any regulations made or to be made in amplification or amendment thereof or in substitution therefor. 3. Utilization of Water and Location of Headworks

Water shall be used under this licence solely for the purpose of generating electricity up to a maximum capacity of 3 kilowatts and shall be taken from the said stream at the point in Section 4s, Block IV, Matakitaki Survey District, indicated on the plan marked S.H.D. 43, deposited in the office of the Minister in Charge of the State Hydro-electric Department.

### 4. General Description of Works

The licensee is hereby authorized, subject to the conditions hereof, to construct, maintain, and use the following works for the purposes of this licence, the positions of the said works being indicated on the said plan S.H.D. 43:—

(a) Headworks consisting of a dam and intake with a water-race leading to the power-house, hereinafter referred to, giving a static head of approximately 20 ft.:

(b) A Pelton wheel and power-house with all necessary equip-

ment for generating electricity:

(c) A tail-race leading from the aforesaid power-house across
Sections 4s and 3s, Block IV, and Section 2s, Block III,
Matakitaki Survey District, and into the Matakitaki

### 5. System of Supply

The system of supply shall be classified under paragraph (d) of clause 21–01 of the Electrical Supply Regulations 1935, and shall be a direct current system.

### 6. DURATION OF LICENCE

Unless sooner determined, this licence shall continue in force until the 31st day of March, 1969.

### 7. RENTAL

For the purpose of assessing the annual rental payable in respect of this licence, the licensee may install a suitable maximum-demand indicator to the satisfaction of the Inspecting Engineer of the State Hydro-electric Department, and, failing such installation, the rental shall be assessed on the maximum generating capacity of the plant installed. The present plant is rated at 3 kilowatts.
