HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section one hundred and twenty-eight of the Public Works Act, 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, of the said Dominion, do hereby approve of the following resolution passed by the Nelson City Council on the nineteenth day of August, one thousand nine hundred and forty-eight, viz.:

"That the Nelson City Council, being the local authority having control of the streets in the City of Nelson, by resolution declares that the provisions of section one hundred and twenty-eight of the Public Works Act, 1928, shall not apply to the south-eastern side of the portion of Emano Street adjoining Lot 4 on the plan deposited in the Land Transfer Office at Nelson as No. 1493, being part of Sections 832 and 833, City of Nelson, and being part of the land comprised and described in Certificate of Title, Volume 74, folio 125 (Nelson Registry)";

subject to the condition that no building or part of a building shall at any time be erected on the land fronting the south-eastern side of the portion of Emano Street (described in the Schedule hereto) within a distance of thirty-three feet from the centre-line of the said portion of street.

THE south-eastern side of all that portion of street situated in the Nelson Land District, City of Nelson, known as Emano Street, fronting part Sections 832 and 833.
