Plants Declared to be Noxious Weeds in the Opotiki County.—(Notice No. Ag. 4559)

THE following special order made by the Opotiki County Council on the 8th day of October, 1948, is published in accordance with the provisions of the Noxious Weeds Act, 1928.

SPECIAL ORDER

"In exercise of the powers conferred on it by the Noxious Weeds Act, 1928, the Opotiki County Council hereby resolves and declares, by way of special order, that the following plants, being plants mentioned in the Second Schedule of the said Act, as extended from time to time by the Governor-General in Council, are noxious weeds within the County of Opotiki:—

- "(1) Winged thistle (*Carduus tenuiflorus*).
- "(2) Milk thistle or variegated thistle (*Silybum marianum*).
- "(3) Bathurst Burr (*Xanthium spinosum*)."
